

B.1 Jaycee Park

Jaycee Park covers two acres surrounding the existing US 421 bridge approach. The park is bordered by E. Vaughn Drive, E First Street, Fillmore Street, and St. Michaels Avenue. The City of Madison owns and maintains this park as a public recreational facility.

The park contains three volleyball courts, playground equipment, two pavilions, 4 picnic tables, multiple benches, a basketball court, a river walk, and a parking area.

The 2007-2012 *Madison Parks and Recreation Master Plan* contains the following planned improvements to the facility:

- Improve sand volleyball courts
- Replacement of both shelters
- Upgrades to the playground equipment

B.2 Madison City Campground

The Madison City Campground is located on the Ohio River just east of Ferry Street, upstream from the existing bridge. The campground covers two acres, has two restroom facilities and provides electrical and water hook-ups for 34 campsites. RV campsites are available for a fee on a daily or weekly basis. The grounds are also equipped with a full bathhouse facility and dump station. The camping season runs from April through October. The City of Madison owns, operates, and maintains the Madison City Campground, located along riverfront and southeast of the Ferry Street intersection with Vaughn Drive.

The 2007-2012 *Madison Parks and Recreation Master Plan* contains the following planned improvements to the facility:

- Repairs to the RV stalls
- Replacing the bathhouse
- Relocating the dump station

B.3 Milton Boat Ramp

The Milton Boat Ramp currently is a paved boat launch facility immediately east of the US 421 Bridge with parking located at the ramp. The boat ramp is the only free facility with access to the Ohio River available for public use in Trimble County. The next nearest boat ramp is in Carrollton, approximately 12 miles away. The City of Milton owns and maintains the public boat launching ramp, located at the northern end of Ferry Street.

B.4 Milton City Park

Milton City Park lies between KY 36 and the base of a wooded ridgeline, between Canip Creek and Maple Street. The park contains open green space, a baseball field, playground equipment, a multi-use path for cyclists and pedestrians, a covered picnic shelter with tables, and a parking area. The area lies within the 100-year floodplain.
