The KYTC and INDOT will hold a Public Information Meeting regarding the Milton-Madison Bridge Project on Tuesday, January 11, 2011 from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. The presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m. and will include an overview of the design-build construction process, highlighting changes which have occurred since Walsh Construction joined the project team as the design-build contractor. Project personnel will be on hand to provide information and answer questions. Comment forms will also be made available for public input at the meeting. The meeting presentation and exhibits will be available on the project Web site following the meeting.

We encourage attendees to share their thoughts and concerns about social, economic, historic and environmental effects upon individuals, businesses and other organizations in the area as a result of the design build construction process being implemented on the project.

Representatives from the KYTC, INDOT, and the Project Consultant will be available to answer questions. Written and oral comments will be accepted during the meeting. Written comments will be accepted, and information made available, up to 15 days after the meeting at the KYTC District 5 Office address listed below. The public meeting presentation and exhibits will also be made available on the project website (www.miltonmadisonbridge.com) following the meeting.

Written and oral comments from this meeting will become part of the official record for the project. This input will also be considered as part of the reevaluation of the Finding of No Significant Impact previously issued by FHWA for the project. Once compiled, the meeting record will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved.
