



LOUISVILLE, KY (September 13, 2011) — The joint annual inspection of the Milton-Madison Bridge — referenced below — has been postponed. Bridge inspectors from INDOT and KYTC are currently focusing their efforts on the Sherman Minton Bridge which carries Interstate 64 between New Albany, IN and Louisville, KY. This bridge was closed last week after inspectors discovered a crack one of the critical load-carrying members of the bridge.

Milton-Madison Bridge reduced to one lane September 14th

LOUISVILLE, KY (August 31, 2011) — The Milton-Madison Bridge, which carries US 421 across the Ohio River from Milton, KY to Madison, IN, will be reduced to one lane on Wednesday, September 14th from 9:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Engineers from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) and the Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will be performing their joint annual inspection of the bridge.

The lane closure is subject to change due to inclement weather and other unforeseen delays.
